
Traditional Origami Bow Tie





This fun bow can be adapted to wear as a hair clip or bow tie, or left as is it can be used as a gift wrapping adornment.

front of paper	valley fold
back of paper	mountain fold
1.	
Fold in half, then unfold	Fold each corner in to meet centre fold
3.	4.
Fold both horizontal edges in to meet centre fold to create a gate fold	Fold in half so that points meet


With point pointing up, fold bottom corners diagonally to meet centre, then unfold

Using existing creases as a guide, fold bottom outer corners to the inside to meet at the centre. You will need to open model a little to achieve this.







Fold top point downwards to open model Fold corners diagonally into centre




Turn model over




Fold tip down to meet tip at bottom




Fold corners diagonally into centre



Rotate 90 degrees, with one flap in each hand, gently pull flaps outward, away from one another
